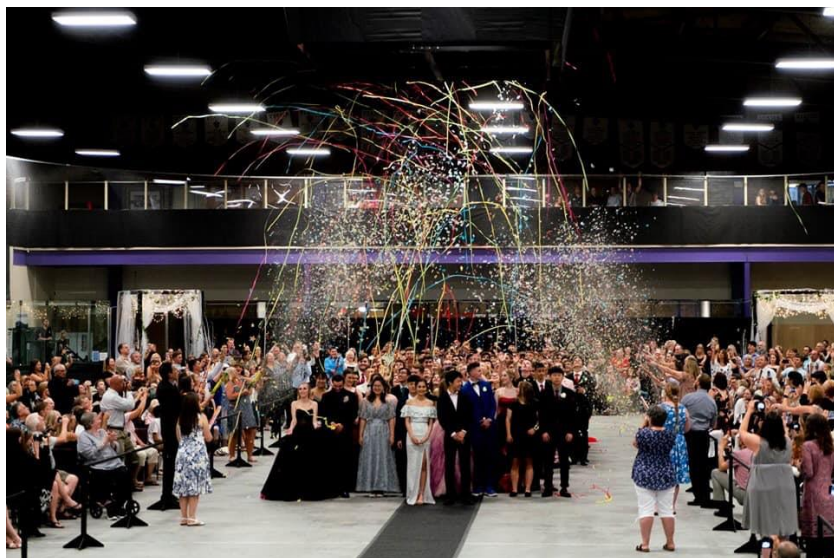

## **2018-2019 - Grade 12 Major Awards – Criteria and Nomination process:**

Each year, Brooks awards 3 major awards to our top **Grade 12 students**. These students are recognized for their contributions to our school community in terms of academics, athletics, arts, service and/or leadership. Students can be nominated by staff and/or students, and forms are ready for pick up at the office throughout the week of June 17-21. Nomination forms are due in the office by **3:20 pm on Friday, June 21, 2019**. We will present these major awards to students at the Brooks' Grade 12 Awards and Scholarship presentation and reception on June 26 from 1 to 3 pm.

The Brooks' Major student awards include:

**The Max Cameron Award** – This award recognises a student that shows exceptional school spirit through service through at least two areas, demonstrates positive outstanding school spirit and is a positive role model. This award come with a trophy, keeper (plaque) and a cheque for \$500.

**The Herb Marion Award** – This award is based on leadership, sportsmanship OR citizenship; demonstrating commitment and cooperation, contributing to school life through service, dedicating at least 30 hours or more in at least one area. This award comes with a trophy, keeper (plaque) and a cheque for \$500.

**The Pauline Galinski Award** – This award is presented with the following criteria: the student must have achieved and maintained an Honour Roll status throughout the year, participated on a school team, service club, or have been very active in the performing arts. They must have committed to at least 30 hours to school through volunteer service, and shown upstanding citizenship and have been an exemplary role model for other students. This award comes with a trophy, keeper (plaque) and a cheque for \$500.
