SUMMER OFFICE HOURS

The office will be open during the summer daily from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm Monday – Friday. We will be closed from July 18th to July 29th

SUMMER SCHOOL

There are three distinct summer school programs at Brooks this year, starting on Monday, July 4, 2022:

Academic Full Credit Courses (grades 10-12):

1. These courses are for students who wish to improve their grade in a course they have already taken or take a new course.
2. Daily attendance is required from 9 a.m. - 1 p.m. (four hours) Mondays through Fridays, for four weeks (July 4-29).

Academic Partial Credit Courses (grades 10-12):

1. These courses are for students who wish to pass a course they have already taken and failed. They must have a final mark of 35% or greater, or else they will need to take the full credit course instead.
2. Daily attendance is required from 9 - 11 a.m. or 11 a.m. - 1 p.m. (two hours) Mondays through Fridays, for four weeks (July 4-29). Students wishing to complete two partial credit courses must attend from 9 a.m. - 1 p.m. (four hours) every day.

Academic Review (grades 8/9):

1. This program is for students who would benefit from extra instruction/support, with an emphasis on literacy and numeracy
2. Daily attendance is required from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m. (three hours) Mondays through Fridays, for three weeks (July 4-21).

Please note there is a strict daily attendance requirement (more than 2 absences may result in withdrawal from the summer school program). Students will not be able to complete summer school courses if they have work or holidays scheduled at the same time. For more information, please go to the [online registration form](#). 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- SD47 Graduation Ceremony and Convocation is being held on Wednesday June 29, 2022,
- The location is at the Hap Parker arena at the Powell River Complex.
- Doors open at 5:00 pm and the ceremony starts at 6:00 pm. The event will be live-streamed.
- Graduates will be wearing their Cap and Gown to cross the stage in the arena.
- Graduates will also receive any awards, scholarships, and bursaries that they have earned.

- Extra tickets are \$10 each and sales have started from the Brooks main office. They are available for sale on a first come first-serve basis.
