PROPOSED ATHLETIC FEE INCREASE FOR NEXT YEAR

Just a quick note that we are about to review our fee structure for athletics / field trips next year. Currently there is a regular cost of \$70 for an overnight trip, and \$25 for an extra night. Regular day ferry trip is \$10.

Given the increases in hotel and gas costs there is a proposal that each of these be raised by \$5. This would result in a \$75, \$30, \$15.
